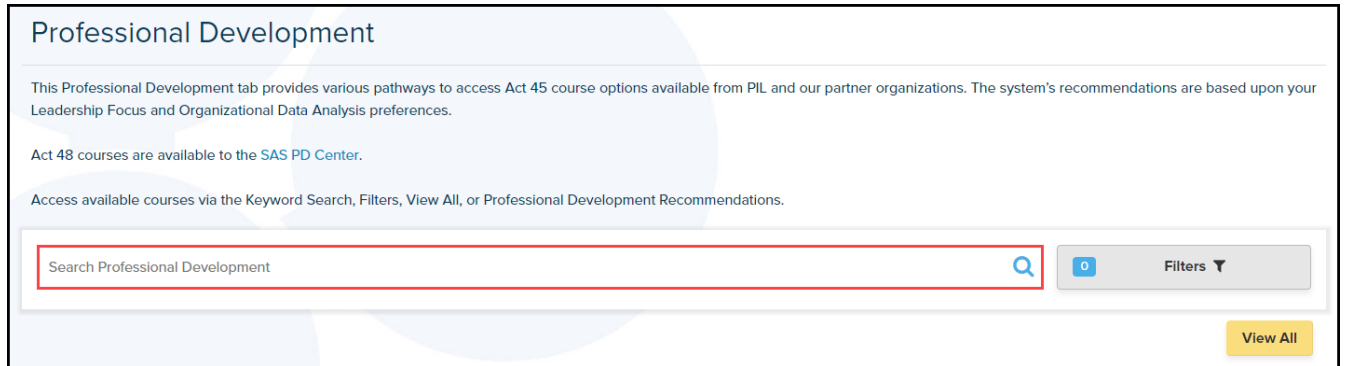

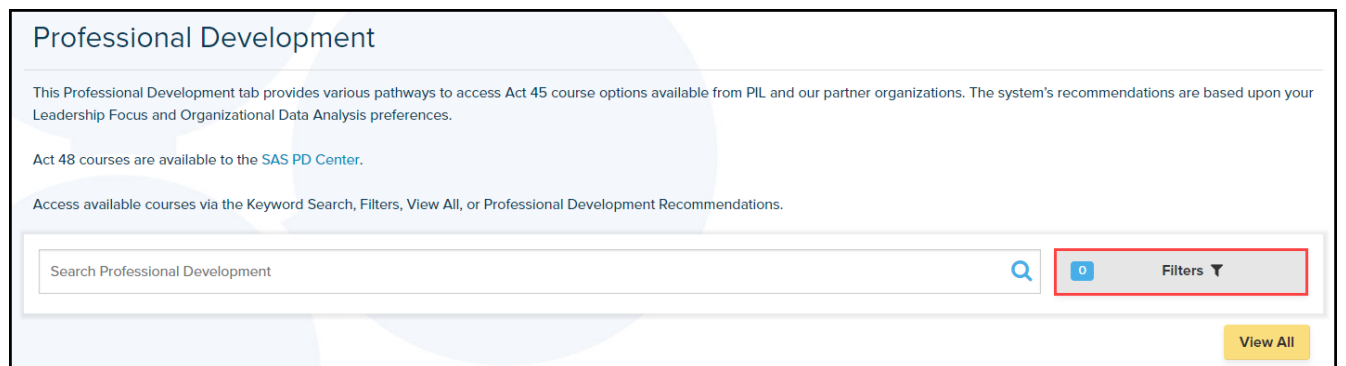
2. Alternatively, click on **Professional Development** in the top SAS Leadership System menu bar to access this section.

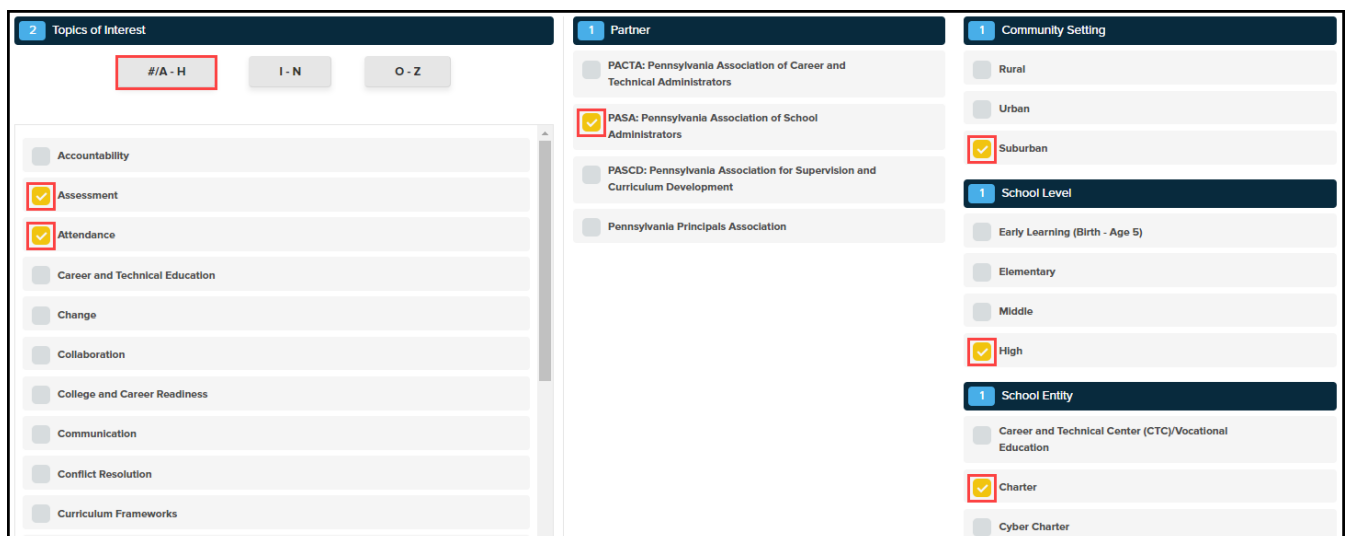
3. To perform a manual search of available Professional Development courses, type a keyword into the search bar and click the magnifying glass icon.



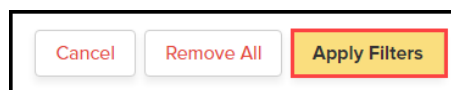
4. To apply a set of filters to a search, click the **Filters** button next to the search bar.



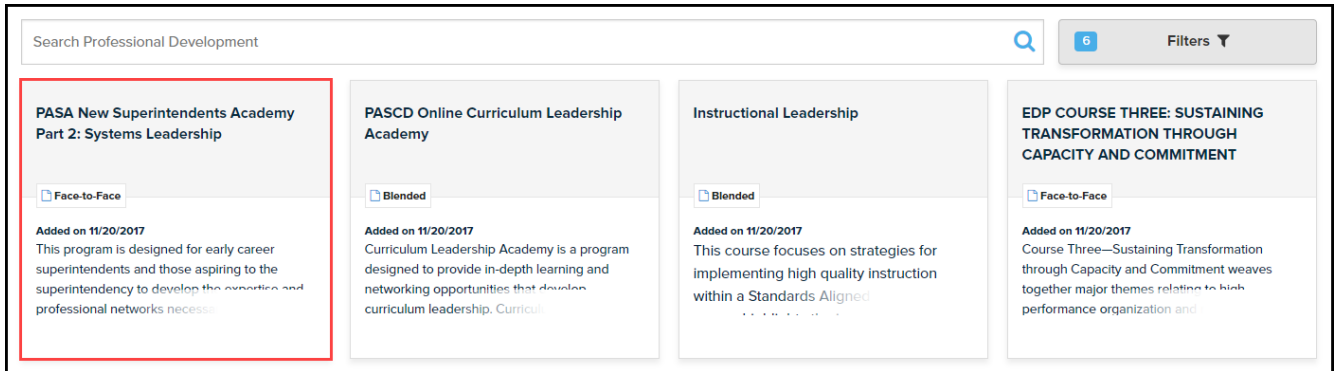

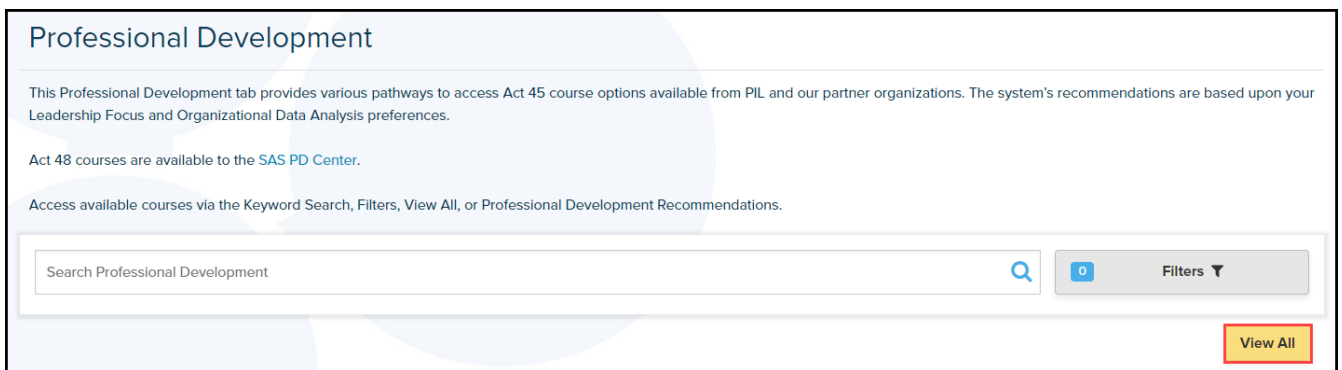
6. Click the **Apply Filters** button to save your selections. If you wish to eliminate your previously selected filters and start a new search, click the **Remove All** button.



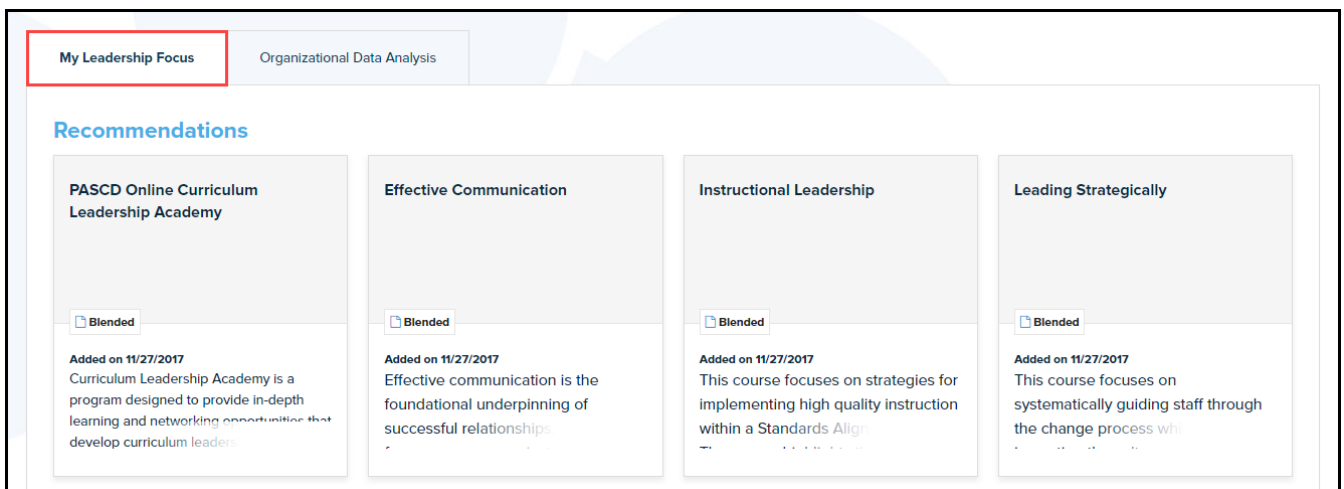
7. After applying your filters, your search results will populate automatically. To view a particular course, click on it for further information.
